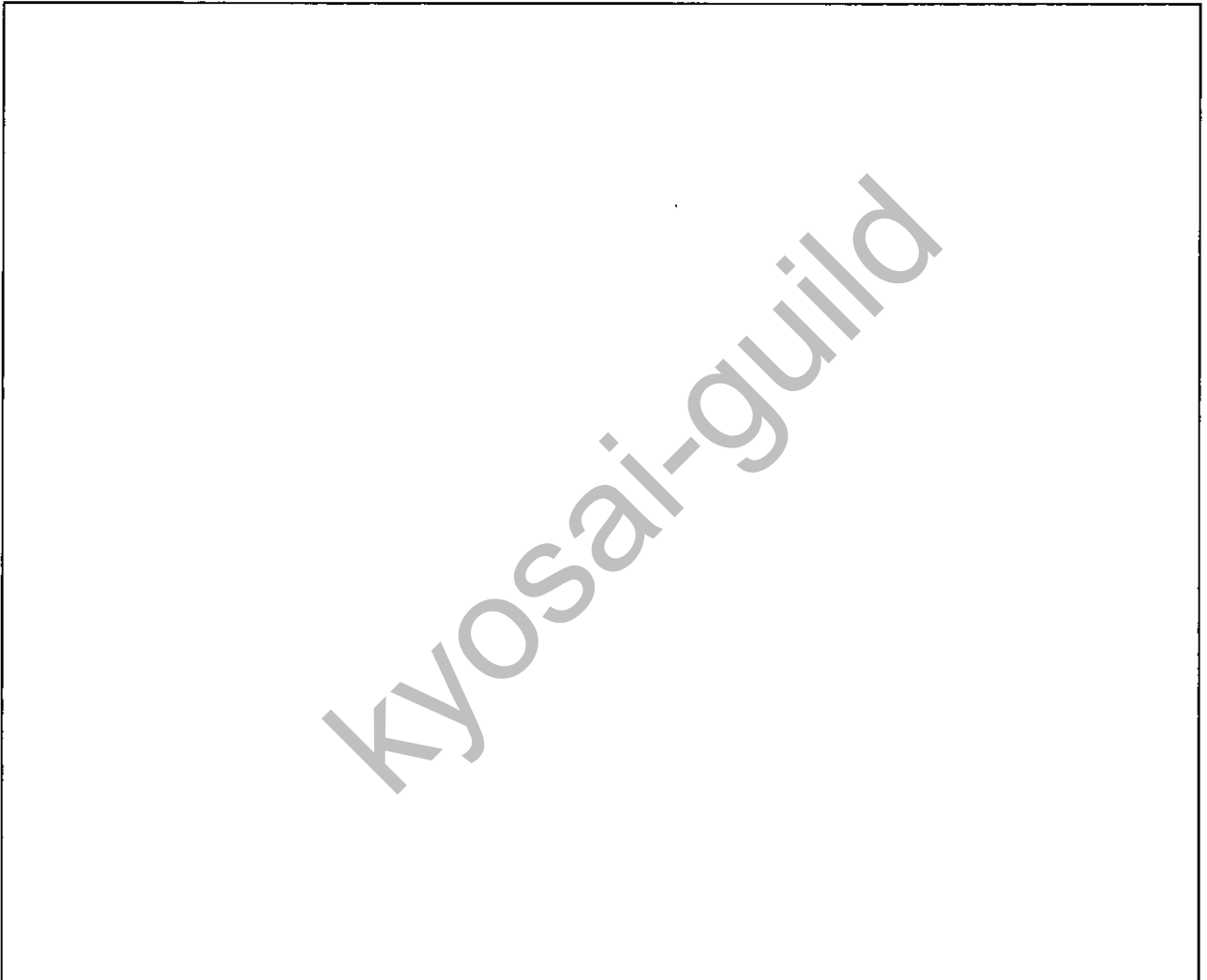
Q1: The interviewee thinks that it is reasonable to stop the introduction of private English tests to the university admissions system. Why is that? Write two reasons.
